

Chatham Savannah Authority for the Homeless (CSAH) Receives HUD Funding for Chatham County Homeless Services

Notification of receipt of \$4,052,707 in HUD funding to serve the Chatham County homeless population was received in late January 2015. The effective date of this funding is March 1, 2015 although actual receipt of funds may be delayed due to constraints in signing of individual contracts.

The umbrella HUD proposal for Chatham County is prepared and submitted annually by CSAH. The funding supports the work of nonprofit organizations, the Housing Authority of Savannah and the City of Savannah. Funds are utilized for supportive housing, case management, and employment and training.
